Training

Our Test Lab is accredited to ISO 17025 by the National Association of Testing Authorities (NATA). This accreditation enables us to issue a Test Report that will be recognised by regulatory bodies throughout Australia and the world.

By using an independent, accredited test lab, you can be confident that your application has been systematically tested and the results you receive are objective and accurate.
